

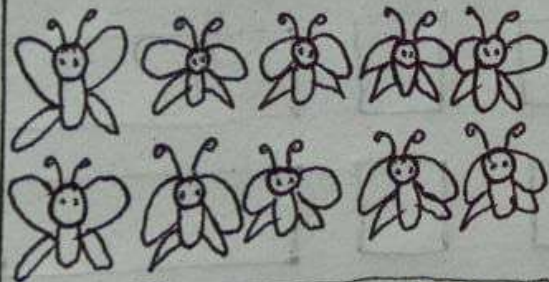
Chapter-6 Numbers from 10 to 20

Ten is written as 10. It is the smallest 2-digit number.

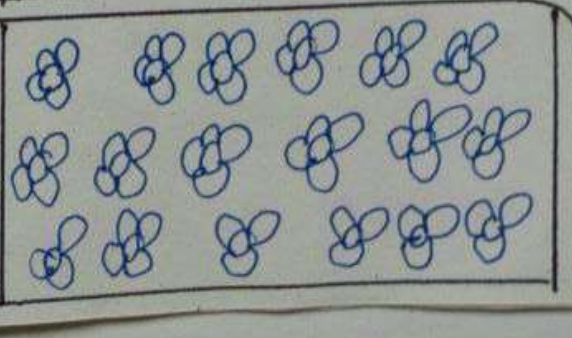
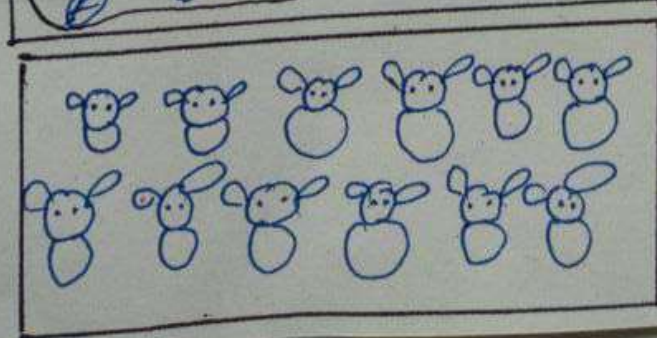
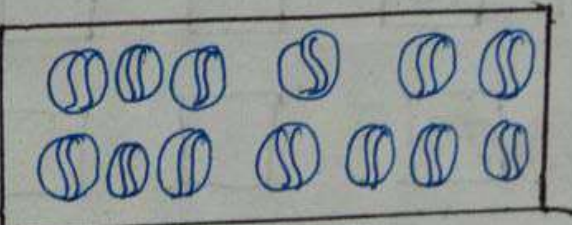
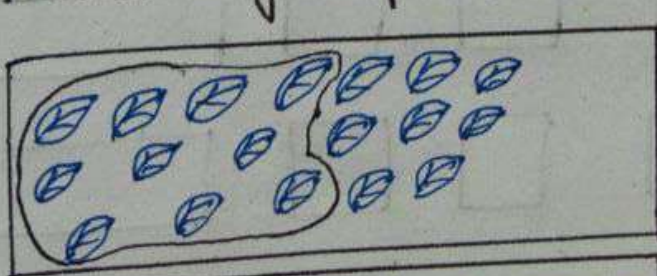


10 butterflies

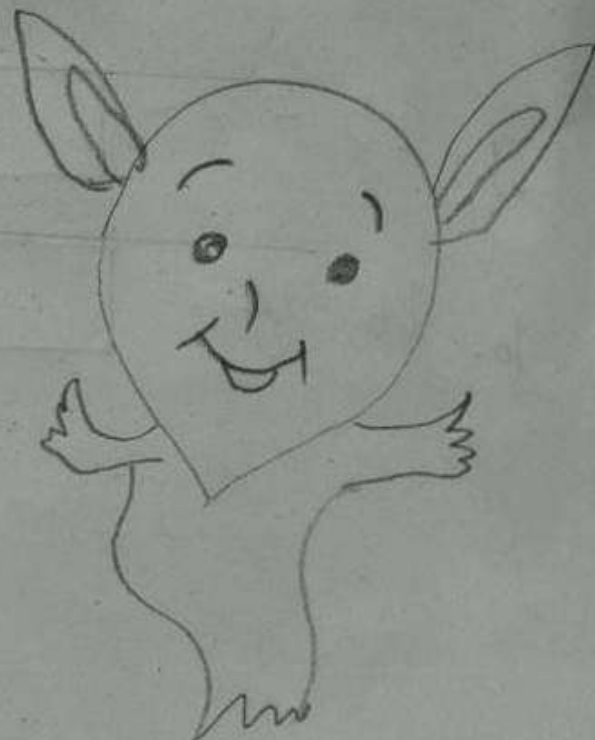
